

<Introduction>

“The Teachings of Demons” by Jeremiah

Today, we are studying the book of Timothy from the perspective of “The Teachings of Demons”.

1 Timothy 4:1 - Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings (doctrines in KJV) of demons

<There will be a rising of the doctrines of demons by the end of time>

The bible describes that in later times (end times in KJV), there will be what we may referred to as “the doctrines of demons”. It is a rising of demonic teachings amongst the churches and a lot of Christians will be misled. This can be seen from the scripture above.

Some may think that the teachings or doctrines of demons have nothing to do with the Christians or the church, but in this scripture it states that “some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons” which clearly tells us that some Christians leave their faith because of demonic teachings.

We can clearly see that this is not a warning to Buddhist or Muslims but specifically to the Christian church.

Therefore, unless we don't care about the Bible or ignore it completely, we need to be aware that there will be demonic teachings by which many people will be misled. What we need to learn from this scripture is that we have to be careful about those teachings (i.e. demonic doctrines).

In present times, people get deceived despite being confident that they were smart enough. More and more people are becoming the victim of fraud and some hundreds billion yens are lost annually.

Although this scripture clearly states that the doctrines of demons will arise in the End time and every Christian can read and understand it, there will be many who end up getting deceived. That is why I would like us to examine this topic this time.

<About “Demonic Doctrines”>

Paul made mention of “the doctrines of demons” in relation to the end of time when he stated, “the Spirit expressly says that in later times...”, he was warning in advance that there will be “the doctrines of demons” which are the special doctrines rising up in the special era for the church known as “the End of Days”.

Christians shouldn’t respond overconfidently saying, “Yeah, we already know that. You don’t need to remind us again”, but should rather stay humble thinking “We are in the era when the doctrines of demons will arise, so we have to be very careful”.

Even before the End of time, the previous days up until now, we have seen some strange heresies and delusions but they were far from being “the doctrines of demons” and just some weird teachings which could be easily distinguished or picked by humans with commonsense or observation.

Some examples may be, “Watch tower Bible and Tract Society” or “The teaching of unifying principle”. They are often talked about in the papers but nonbelievers can easily understand how strange and heretic they are. Even newspapers and magazines mention that these teachings are nonsense.

But just because you are able to spot those “Doctrines of heresy created by humans” doesn’t mean you are also able to spot “The doctrines of demons in The End of time” which is specifically mentioned in the Bible.

<Demons are smarter than humans>

Here is the question. Between humans and demons, who is smarter? The answer can be found in what “demon” literally means in Greek (Daimonion). It is stated in the dictionary that “Daimonion is the spiritual existence. It is below God but above humans”.

Therefore, we can see that demons are smarter than humans. What Paul really wanted to say in the previous scripture from Timothy was “You have to be extremely careful during The End of time as it is a special era when the churches will be under the attack of the doctrines of demons which are far stronger than any others before.

What we have to realize, understand, and be cautious of is that it is easy for demons to deceive humans as they are smarter and more cunning than us. We shouldn’t be arrogant saying “They can’t do much anyway” or “I am sure that I will never be tricked”.

We should not forget that the first woman, Eve was also fooled by the devil’s temptation and consequently banned from being around the Tree of Life.

<It is hard to detect the doctrines of demons>

What are the doctrines of demons like? I presume that they will be hard to detect as being the doctrines of heresy, but rather consistent enough to accept without doubt, hence, many people can be tricked by them.

The latest fraud schemes are getting more sophisticated with people acting as policemen, lawyers and others, making the story quite believable. They are definitely not simple techniques at all.

<What the doctrines of demons are aiming for?>

What is the purpose of Satan by bringing the doctrines of demons into the churches as written in the book of Timothy? According to the Bible, it is obviously to take the eternal life away from Christians. The Lord describes Satan as “the murderer since the beginning”, so we need to understand that Satan and demons are focusing on taking Christians’ most precious eternal life with their doctrines.

<The doctrines of demons will be brought right into the core of the Christian church>

What we also need to know for sure is that the doctrines of demons will be taught in the Christian church not outside. To help you understand this, let’s think about the day the Lord came down to the earth.

Despite the fact that our savior Lord Jesus Christ appeared to God’s people as it was prophesized in the Bible, rabbis and Pharisees who were supposed to be the teachers of the Bible at the time couldn’t recognize or understand Him. Why? That was because they were trapped by a strange teaching, the doctrine of demons.

As a result, unbelievably, they captured and arrested the savior who was promised in the Bible, took Him to the court, and eventually killed Him. I bet they have been thrown into Gehenna because of this. Tricked by the doctrine of demons, they lost eternal life.

You see how horrific the result is if you get deceived by the doctrines of demons? You can also see that the doctrines of demons deceived the very elect of God. What happened when Christ came to earth will be repeated when He returns. We can just imagine that the doctrines of demons which become so dominant in the central core of Christianity, resulting in many of God’s people losing eternal life.

<The Catholic Church has been infiltrated by the doctrines of demons>

We can see that today's Christian churches, especially the Catholic Church, has been infiltrated by the doctrines of demons. As a result, they are destined to lose eternal life.

The Pope says, "Evolution is so scientific that I can't deny it". What he is saying here is that the Genesis of creation in the Bible where it describes that God created humans is just a story. Catholic Christians who hear such doctrine will lose the faith in the Bible and our savior Jesus Christ.

In addition, the Pope teaches that hell doesn't exist. Such teachings of lies will put the Catholic Christians off their guard placing them in danger of going to hell. Here, we can see that the doctrines of demons are indeed dominant in the Catholic Church.

<Protestants are also being infiltrated by the doctrines of demons>

How about the Protestant? My understanding is that it is also dominated by these doctrines and it seems that the core doctrine is compromised. For example, according to the Protestant teaching, it says that as long as you are called to be a Christian, you are saved and not going to hell.

If this is true, everyone would be happy and what a great teaching it is. But by examining the words of the Bible a bit, we can see that this teaching is nonsense and has nothing to do with the Lord's teaching. This teaching is full of demonic idea which deceives Christians to keep them away from eternal life. Now, let's examine the inconsistency in this teaching by reading the Bible scriptures.

(Narrow gate)

The Lord said about eternal life that its road and gate are narrow as stated below.

Matthew 7:13"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it.

7:14 But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

The Lord said that the gate to eternal destruction is big, its road is wide, and many people go through it. Also He clearly stated that the gate to eternal life is small, its road is narrow, and only a few people will find it.

Despite the words of the Lord's, Christian churches these days teach that once you have confessed that Jesus is Lord and you are baptized, you will definitely have eternal life no matter what. This teaching is completely demonic, giving Christian's peace of mind which is not biblical, preventing them from having eternal life.

(Wise virgin and foolish virgin)

Christians are seen as the bride of Christ but the Bible doesn't say that it means all Christians will be accepted as the bride of Christ.

Rather, it states that there will be a selection amongst candidates of the bride where wise virgins will be welcomed but foolish ones wouldn't, and the Lord will tell them that He doesn't know them. It is written thus:

Matthew 25:10 But while they were on their way to buy the oil, the bridegroom arrived. The virgins who were ready went in with him to the wedding banquet. And the door was shut.

25:11 Later the others also came. "Lord, Lord," they said, "open the door for us!"

25:12 But he replied, 'Truly I tell you, I don't know you.'

Therefore, accepting Christ, receiving salvation, and living as a Christian is one thing, how you live is another. It is true based on biblical doctrines that the end result depends on how you live your life. While some will be accepted by Christ as the wise virgins, unfortunately, others won't.

We have to know that it is actually demonic doctrines spreading all over the place in the modern era which tell that as long as you refer to yourself as a Christian, Christ will accept you as His bride when the time comes.

(Wheat and weeds)

Christians are also seen as wheat. Wheat is necessary for bread, and bread means the word of life. Since Christians grow by listening to the word of life, wheat also represents Christians. The Bible clearly tells that the wheat, when it comes to the fate of Christians, is separated from the weeds. It doesn't say that all what is called "wheat" will not necessarily go to heaven. It is stated below.

Matthew 13:29 "No," he answered, "because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them.

13:30 Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.”

13:38 The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one,

13:39 and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels.

13:40 “As the weeds are pulled up and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the age.

13:41 The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil.

13:42 They will throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

As stated here, the Bible teaches that all Christians are not the same, just as there is a difference between good wheat and weeds. The lesson here is that Christians who choose to abide with the right doctrine can be likened to good wheat and will inherit the kingdom of heaven, but those who choose the wrong doctrine are like weeds and they will be burnt by fire. I hope you can see how it is not unscriptural to insist that every Christian is like good wheat therefore will inherit the kingdom of heaven.

<The doctrines of the End Times are penetrated by the teachings of the devil>

We have learned that the doctrines of eternal life for Christians is already dominated by demonic doctrines. We also need to know that other doctrines, especially the doctrine of the End Times, are strongly dominated by demonic doctrines as well.

There is extensive description and explanation about the End Times and the reason behind it?

According to the correct doctrines,

1. All Christians experience troubles and tribulations.
2. Many Christians would be misled in the end times
3. Many Christians and churches would ignore the faith in the end time.

The doctrines of the End Times preached are...

1. Deceiving Christians by saying that troubles and tribulations in End Times will only happen to a particular people (e.g. the Jews) and have nothing to do with Christians.
2. Deceiving Christians by saying that the church will be raptured to heaven before the tribulation therefore there is no need for preparation.
3. Not telling about churches turning their back on the faith which is clearly mentioned in the Bible.

What we can see in the teachings of demons is that it mentions something positive, fun, and easygoing to deceive Christians into destruction. All end time doctrines which are being preached in current churches meet these criteria, and they are trying to give Christians unwarranted peace to lead them into destruction. We need to understand that everyone preaching this kind of teaching is a false prophet who wears sheep's clothing. It is stated in scriptures:

Matthew 7:15 Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.

Specifically, the doctrines of End Times by Hal Lindsay or Left Behind seem to be nothing but the teachings of demons. I will explain more about this next.

I would like to share my testimony about what I have learned recently through the message on Jeremiah's website.

By the way, have you visited our church website? The details are on the last page of the newsletter. Anyway, the title of message number 244 was "The words of Sardis" and I felt God was speaking to me something very important, therefore I decided to share here with you.

The scripture goes like this.

Revelation 3:1-6

1. "To the angel of the church in Sardis write:

These are the words of him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead.

2 Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God.

3 Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; hold it fast, and repent. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you.

4 Yet you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes. They will walk with me, dressed in white, for they are worthy.

5 The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels.

6 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

As I previously said, **“the church in Sardis”** means “Protestant’s church”. What this scripture is telling us is that because the salvation of the Protestants is in danger, we need to wake up and repent, as is shown in verse 3, to stay safe. Pastor Jeremiah also gave us a message on this in his newsletter before, so if you would like to know more, I suggest you read the archive. (Just let us know and we will send it to you)

Now, what I would like to explain here is the phrase **“what remains”** in verse 2. In the message number 244 of Jeremiah’s website, it explains as follows.

Now, on to the phrase, “the rest of people” in other part. The phrase “the rest of people” has special meaning in the Bible and it originates from the people who returned to Israel on the day of Babylon to rebuild Jerusalem. They were God’s chosen people but now even the small group of “the rest of people” are on the brink of extinction. We can therefore see how dangerous the situation is.

Let me explain a bit further. “The people who returned to Israel on the day of Babylon to rebuild Jerusalem” were the ones such as Ezra or Nehemiah who took part in rebuilding the palace and city. What they actually rebuilt was the doctrine and spiritual truth as they were completely twisted

To rebuild Jerusalem, these needed to be fixed in the same way we need the real doctrine of the church and the spiritual truth to be brought back at the moment. This is very important for us Christians who are living in End Times described in the New Testament.

We have already started practicing it at Remnant Church. And just like the days of Ezra and Nehemiah, recovering the real doctrine and spiritual truth are being practiced by those who separate themselves from wrong doctrine of Babylon and its church (I think America is Babylon of our time), then enter Sukkot (the underground church).

And it is mentioned that even amongst those “the rest of people” who are working in the underground church, some are **“about to die”**.

The Remnant Church of Jesus Christ is an underground church which the Bible describes as “the church in the wild”. But we are told that it doesn’t guarantee any safety (for more information about this, please read message number 244 on our website).

As I previously said, while the country of the beast, “the United States” grows continuously, the teaching of the anti-Christ will dominate the churches. For example, any church which does not accept homosexuality will be seen as illegal based on the law. The Bible talks about this and often recommends us to work in the underground church to recover the doctrine and spiritual truth. Therefore, it is right to leave the public church and get involved with the underground church, but it doesn’t imply that everything will be alright.

When I left what was called “The Orthodox Church”, one of its members called me, asking why I decided not to come to church. As I explained to this person and said “I am saved now because I go to the church in the wild. I have also been able to walk away from wrong doctrines like Pre-tribulation”, this person said “What are you talking about? There is no such thing as safe place!” Because I couldn’t accept it immediately, I prayed and asked, “Lord, I am with the church in the wild now, but is it still not enough?” Then, later God spoke to me like this. “That is right. You are not saved just because you are with the church in the wild. It was surely the right thing to do when you left the public church, but it was just the beginning of changing your attitude and turning around. It all depends on if you are willing to live your life rightfully afterwards”. Of course God didn’t literally speak to me but rather this message just came up in my heart.

So, when I read the message in Jeremiah’s room’s website, I couldn’t help but to say “Yeah, that makes sense!” Although there were differences in timing when Pastor

Jeremiah wrote the message, I changed my direction, and God spoke to me, I still feel that the same Spirit is always guiding us.

The book of Revelation made mention of a prostitute called Babylon that symbolizes wrong doctrine or the spirit of the United States. I felt that God was challenging me to think that it may be the time to start the underground church movement, just like the Bible says "Come out of her". So, once I entered the underground church, I would like to have the right attitude and live my life accordingly. I will be cautious not to be seen as someone who is "about to die" by God, because then the kingdom of heaven would be in danger.

May glory and honor be to God who always gives us important messages.
