

**“The codes in the Bible imply that the U.S is the country of the beast” by Jeremiah**

<The codes in the Bible were put by God>

This time, we would like to discuss “The codes in the Bible which imply that the U.S is the country of the beast”.

The book called “The Bible code” by Michael Drosnin made it well known the fact that there are codes in the Bible. This was confirmed by several magazines specializing in mathematics in the U.S, and even an essay was published as well. This tells us that this is not a lie or a misunderstanding that there are codes in the Bible. Now, the question is who did it? The answer of course is God who wrote the Bible with spiritual inputs.

**2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:**

<Searching for the word, the U.S will lead you to the book of Daniel where it talks about worshipping an idol>

The Stephan brothers searched the codes in the Bible by using the U.S as a keyword. I would like to refer to his quote and according to him the word the U.S in Hebrew appeared in Daniel.

**Daniel 3:3 Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.**

**3:4 Then an herald cried aloud, To you it is commanded, O people, nations, and languages,**

**3:5 That at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:**

This is a famous scripture where three friends of Daniel get persecuted because they refused to worship an idol that was built by the King of Babylon. This can be seen as an indication of what will happen in End Times because Revelation also states that people who don't worship the idol of the beast will be killed.

We can see that "the U.S" almost appeared in the Bible as it prophesizes what happens during the tribulation. The code tells us that the U.S leads the tribulation here.

<The meaning of idol worshipping>

Let's think about the meaning of worshipping the idol of the beast. We will look at the book of Daniel.

**Daniel 3:3 Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.**

At the time, the King of Babylon had just established the biggest empire in the world and ruled the world. It is believed that Babylon will reappear in End Times. The Bible indeed prophesize that in the book of Revelation as we can see in the scripture reference below.

**Revelation 17:4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:**

**17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, Mystery, Babylon The Great, The Mother Of Harlots And Abominations Of The Earth.**

So it is correct to assume that the righteous Christians will be persecuted in End Times just like the three friends of Daniel. In End Times, it will be the U.S who persecutes the righteous Christians.

The word America is found in Skip 17 of Daniel 3:3-5

On this day, the King of Babylon gathered **the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces.**

In the same way, the U.S, the country of the beast, will conquer the world and gather the representatives from each country to give them on order. As it is written, the order is for all the people of the world, especially Christians, to forcefully “worship an idol”.

<An idol is a parable of a person>

So, what does an idol represent? Revelation gives us a clue.

**Revelation 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.**

**13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.**

“Image” is a parable and worshipping the image means more about worshipping an anti-Christ rather than statues. The word “image” is used in the scripture below as well.

**Colossians 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:**

Here, it describes Christ as an invisible image. Although we can’t see God with our physical eyes, we can still see His image through Christ.

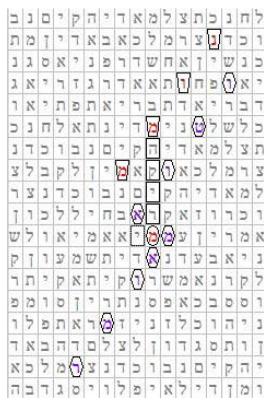
In the same way, the image of the beast also reflects on who the beast is. An anti-Christ

is a human being, but this person shows the beast's quality. He will go against Jesus Christ in End Times.

<Dedicatory ceremony>

The King of Babylon gathered all officers from the world and held dedicatory ceremony of the idol. We can understand that this prophesizes that the anti-Christ will be presented to the world in End Times.

Therefore, anti-Christ will not appear quietly without us knowing it. He would rather make a grand entry to this world with the support of the U.S. As the result, this person must be known to every single person in the world.

<Anti-Christ will be placed on the throne of Christ>

There is an astonishing fact about an anti-Christ. He will drag Christ down from the throne and place himself in there instead. The book of Thessalonians prophesizes about the day as below.

**2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;**

**2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is**

## **God.**

This scripture tells us about the terrible day. First of all, there will be apostasy when the churches no longer worship Christ as a Savior. In Greek, apostasy also means “to leave”. This means the church will divorce Christ and start to have a new relationship with another person; anti-Christ. This is how apostasy happens.

<He as God sitteth in the temple of God>

The temple of God is not something like the third temple in Jerusalem, but rather the churches. It says as below.

**Ephesians 2:20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;**

**2:21 In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:**

Therefore, what **he as God sitteth in the temple of God** in Thessalonians describes is that an anti-Christ will come into the churches and drive Christ out to place himself in that position. He will false proclaim himself to be the god of churches and describe Christ as a liar. This will be the beginning of a terrible era.

The Lord described this day as below.

**Matthew 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)**

People who say the Holy place is the third temple don't really understand the Bible because there is no more Holy place than the churches. So, an anti-Christ will indeed come and occupy the place of Christ in the churches.

**Daniel 3:4 Then an herald cried aloud, To you it is commanded, O people, nations, and languages,**

**3:5 That at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery,**

**dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:**

We can see here that it is talking about worshipping the image as well as musical instruments. Why is that? The musical instruments are used to worship and praise God in the churches, so through this description, it prophesizes that one day we will start worshipping an anti-Christ.

<Golden image>

Golden image also has hidden meaning; faith. Let's take a look at the scripture below.

**1 Peter 1:7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:**

Therefore, we can see that an anti-Christ will become someone that people respect and worship because this godly person performs miracles and wonders.

**Daniel 3:6 And whoso falleth not down and worshippeth shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.**

It describes that people who don't worship the idol of Babylon will be killed. This must happen in End Times, too. Revelation also talks about killing people who refuse to worship anti-Christ as below.

**Revelation 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.**

<We should leave apostate church>

To avoid this, the Lord recommends us to leave the apostate church as below.

**Matthew 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)**

**24:16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:**

**24:17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:**

**24:18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.**

**24:19 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!**

**24:20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:**

Here, the Lord tells the people on the roof not to come back in the house, and in the field not to return home to get clothes. This is a parable. The house is the church and it means that we shouldn't return to apostate churches that worship an anti-Christ. Instead, it recommends us to stay on the roof which also means the underground church.

<The U.S is trying to make us start worshipping an anti-Christ>

As mentioned above, the code in the Bible clearly states that the U.S is indeed the country of the beast, but how is the U.S is faring at the moment? Well, we can surely see that this country is becoming the country of the beast and has started to worship an anti-Christ.

Right now, the name of Jesus Christ is being removed in many places. Even people want to stop using the word Christmas because there is "Christ" in it. Also preachers and people who hand out brochures are getting arrested.

What happens in the end? I guess the churches will drive Christ out and accept an anti-Christ. The Bible prophesizes that the country of the beast is the U.S and the code also confirms it. We should keep our eyes on this country.

**“What I learned from Sunday service” by E3**

This time, I would like to introduce what Pastor Jeremiah shared at Sunday service in December 2014. It was about “teachers” from James.

**James 3:1 My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.**

We should listen to this and remember. As it says, **“We shall receive the greater condemnation”**, being a teacher is tough because while you receive blessings if you teach the word of God correctly, you will get punishment if you fail to do so. The Lord didn’t just call the rabbis and Pharisees “Child of Gehenna” for nothing but simply because the way they served resembled to be the one. Indeed, they neglected the righteousness and loving God, and ended up getting destroyed. Sure, there are lots of attacks on pastors but God’s will for them is to lead people correctly therefore you will receive blessings if you obey Him.

**James 3:2 For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.**

The word “offend” means “pull legs” in Greek. This describes that pastors and teachers can pull legs of Christians. Offending in word is the worst problem. You could speak against someone or the Bible. Therefore if you want to become a teacher, you will have to be careful about what you say. **“Bridle the whole body”** indicates directing the whole church into the right path which tells us that James emphasizes on the importance of doctrine and teachings.

**James 3:3 Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.**

“Horse” describes the church, and “bits” are pastors that lead the church.

**James 3:4 Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.**



“Ships” are churches and “helm” is teacher. This tells us that no matter how big a church is, it could be manipulated by a teacher. This shows how important a teacher is to determine the direction of the church.

**James 3:5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!**

“Tongue” is also a parable of teacher. This part describes the trouble caused by a teacher. “Boasteth” shows that a teacher can cross the boundary as a result excessive pride.

**James 3:6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.**

“Whole body” means the church. This scripture tells us that it gets burned by the fire of Gehenna and destroyed. Let’s take a look at what this part says teachers need to be careful about. First of all, they need to be careful about what they say. They should also watch out what kind of doctrine they teach because you could influence your audience spiritually. Therefore teachers are messengers too who have to live righteously. If you don’t intend doing so, you better not do this job otherwise you would get severe punishment. They don’t just teach doctrine but influence spiritually as well.

**James 3:7 For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind:**

**3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.**

It says teachers and pastors are not going to be punished.

**James 3:9 Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.**

**3:10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.**

It says that if you don’t live righteously there will be cursing spirit no matter how

impressive your talk sounds. You may think what pastors and teachers speak will always be blessings, but as you can see **“Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing”**, both blessings and curses can come out of teachers. That is why it is important to judge messages carefully. It is dangerous to accept any kind of message because it could be a curse.

**James 3:11 Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter?**

**3:12 Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh.**

Here, it talks about “water” which is about teachers. Water represents spiritual elements with **“sweet water”** being Holy Spirit and **“bitter water”** demons. Again, we can see that there are both sweet and bitter water coming out of a teacher’s mouth. Although it shouldn’t, we need to accept that will happen. Because the person himself is unable to realize it, it is our job to watch carefully.

**James 3:13 Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.**

It is talking about how we should express wisdom and teaching which were shown by God to pass on to people. We should do so with gentle behavior. Because it all depends on how we express the truth, we will be used by God as we approach gently.

**James 3:14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.**

This is teaching for pastors and teachers. Teachers somehow have pride, and they also have tendency of going against the truth and lie. This is a warning against teachers.

**James 3:15 This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.**

**3:16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.**

It also talks about teachers. Verse 15 is about demonic teaching and it tells us that could happen to the church.

**James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.**

While demonic teaching comes into the church, it talks about the wisdom from God. The correct teaching is demonstrated through peace, generosity, and gentleness therefore no matter how clearly you have had a revelation, if it is demonstrating hatred without mercy it is definitely not from God.

**James 3:18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.**

Indeed, we would like to sow seeds in peace.

That is what Pastor Jeremiah preached about “teachers” and I would be delighted if you could understand this.

I give thanks to God who always teaches us something important.
