

<Introduction>

“Devil’s cup” by Jeremiah

This time we would like to talk about the “Devil’s cup”. We will look at how anyone who receives the spirit of the revival in the U.S would end up receiving the Devil’s cup.

Let’s start by reading from 1 Corinthians 10:7.

1 Corinthians 10:7 Neither be ye idolaters, as were some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.

When the Bible says “The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play”, this is related to idol worship which takes the communion of idols inside the churches.

We should be careful not to worship great people in End Times. The Bible prophesizes that the churches will apostate in End Times and one of the biggest sins to be committed by then is idol worshipping as written in the scripture reference below..

Revelation 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

The image of God describes an anti-Christ. This tells us that those idols will be anti-Christ and people will start worshipping them as if they are gods.

1 Corinthians 10:11 Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

This scripture explains about the Israelites who committed sins, died in the wilderness, and failed to enter the Promised Land. It was not just a fairy tale but the Bible says “they are written for our admonition”. This means idol worshipping could happen around us and if we get influenced by it, we will indeed fail to enter the kingdom of heaven like those Israelites. Therefore, we should be really careful about this sin. God talked about this as we can see in the scripture reference below in relation to idol worship.

Exodus 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.

This is a very important teaching for Christians of this era. Sure, we don't worship statues or symbols like other people, but Christians can easily idolize particular people in the church. Then it would be against the command; "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image".

Acts like worshipping Benny Hinn and willingly receiving the wine from people like him is absolutely idol worship which is exactly what is warned against here.

1 Corinthians 10:14 Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry.

Again, Paul is talking about avoiding "idolatry". He is not warning for non-Christians but Christians so we need to humbly listen to this and make sure we don't get confused to worship idols. However, unfortunately, there are many idol worshiping activities going on in current Christian churches.

Revival of demons conducted by Benny Hinn

1 Corinthians 10:15 I speak as to wise men; judge ye what I say.

Paul wanted to talk about idolatry as if he was talking to wise men. This tells us that there are many parables and mysteries included in his explanation. He was talking something that God's wisdom was required to fully grasp its meaning. It was the ultimate secret of idolatry.

1 Corinthians 10:16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?

When talking about idolatry, Paul mentioned bread and wine for the communion in the beginning. Unless you understand what it truly means, you will never understand the true meaning of idolatry. Drinking wine means drinking the blood of Jesus Christ and this has a relationship with the Holy Spirit. In the same way, eating bread means taking the body of Christ in.

In End Times, this communion becomes compromised. You may come to the church thinking you would receive the Holy Spirit but could end up being exposed to demonic spirits instead.

**1 Corinthians 10:17 For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.**

It is right to have everyone in the church have access to one bread and one body; Jesus Christ. But you will receive other bread and teaching at the churches of apostasy in End Times. Pre-tribulation theory is a prime example of teachings which is not from Christ.

**1 Corinthians 10:18 Behold Israel after the flesh: are not they which eat of the sacrifices partakers of the altar?**

It is talking about the importance of eating from the altar. In Israel, eating itself means an act of worship and having a relationship with God. In the same way, eating and drinking what is prepared for idols can lead you to worshipping demons.

Right now, if you attend the revival meeting and receive bread (message from anti-Christ), it could mean joining idol worship and having a relationship with demons. You may think you have just been to a meeting and received a good message but in God's eye you are seen to have had a relationship with demons. You could even be seen as someone who has chosen to change to demonic worship.

**1 Corinthians 10:19 What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is anything?**

Now, there is always misunderstandings about idol worship amongst Christians.

Some say “idols have no power because they are not real gods therefore you don’t need to worry about anything. You can eat and drink from idols and there is no effect on you”. For example, a Buddha’s statue is just a statue made from steel. They say even Christians can worship it or eat something which was given to it without problems.

In the same way, some may say that even if you attend a revival meeting held by a dodgy person, this is just a person after all so you won’t get influenced at all. This is a big misunderstanding.

**1 Corinthians 10:20 But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils.**

Here, Paul explains “the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God”. This means that although the statue itself has no power, worshipping it leads to worshipping devils. The statue is not alive but devils are, therefore we will end up having a relationship with them and get influenced.

So, Benny Hinn is indeed just a person but if you attend his meeting and receive his spirit it means you are receiving the devil’s cup. Having a relationship with Benny Hinn isn’t a big deal but interacting with devils will lead to devastating consequences.

That is why we have to be really careful about attending strange revival meetings.

**1 Corinthians 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.**

Therefore, it is strange to take communion at the Christian church while attending a strange revival meeting at the same time. Because it means to “drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils”.

**1 Corinthians 10:22 Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he?**

So, we need to know that if you attend a meeting held by an evil person like Benny Hinn you are going to eat something sacrificed for idols and receive the cup of devils. If Christians do that, it will end up bringing the wrath of God upon us.

<Cup of the Whore of Babylon>

So, once you understand about a cup dedicated for an idol, you will come to understand what the cup of the Whore of Babylon in Revelation means. Let's read the scripture.

Revelation 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

It says that this wine of Babylon is the wine of the wrath of her fornication. Why does God get angry about the wine of Babylon?

Corinthians describes that God becomes jealous when you drink the cup of devils, so it is right to presume that the wine of Babylon is the wine of devils. In terms of the relationship between Babylon and devils, it is described as we can see from the scripture reference below.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

As you can see, there is a relationship between Babylon and devils. It has also taken place already. Benny Hinn, Rodney Howard, Kenneth Copeland are examples of devil worshippers. If Christians receive a cup from these people, it is a sinful act because you are interacting with devils. This means that the people of God neglected the Lord's table, drank the wine of devils and that leads to God's wrath.

“She made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication”

What is the problem of Babylon (the churches of the U.S)? First of all, they misunderstood the devils' wine, became enthusiastic about it, and started to export this devils' revival to many other nations. The Bible describes it as “She made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication”

Revelation 18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

This revival of devils will spread across the churches in the world but it is the wine of the wrath which causes God's anger. Therefore Christians need to read this part correctly and understand what is happening in this era with the help of the Holy Spirit. We should understand what it means biblically to witness people like Benny Hinn gaining popularity.

What we can see then is not God's amazing work spreading across the churches in the world. Rather, the wrath of God is increasing towards the fact that the Christian churches in the world are turning into idol worshipping. Also God is upset that his people neglect the table of God and happily drink the wine of devils. Anyone who understands this and stays away from the devils' cup will be blessed.



The cup of Babylon is the cup of devils.

False doctrine about return of Christ

Today, I would like to introduce the sermon of Pastor Jeremiah which was shared in October 2015. I really wanted to share about the return of Christ with fellow Christians so I hope you find this interesting.

Below is the message from Ps. Jeremiah.

The doctrine which teaches us that Christ will come back twice has never been shared in the long history of Christianity until recently. Even the early church era didn't have anyone preaching things like this. But around 1830, J.N Derby from UK started spreading this doctrine and it was followed by C.I.Scotland when he published the Bible with special notes.

<The day of Lord and The day of Christ>

People like Scofield insists that there is “The day of the Lord” as well as “The day of Christ”.

According to them, the difference is as follows.

The day of Christ” The day of love and His people are going to be rewarded”

1 Corinthians 1:8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1:10 That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ.

Isaiah 2:12 For the day of the Lord of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low:

2 Thessalonians 2:2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

2 Thessalonians 2:2 (Darby’s version) That ye be not soon shaken in mind, nor troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter, as [if it were] by us, as that the day of the Lord is present.

As you can see, there is The day of the Lord and The day of Christ day in the Bible translated by J.N. Darby and some other versions are the same.

According to the doctrine of Darby and others, saints are supposed to be raised when Christ returns “first time”. It may look like He comes back twice because there is The day of the Lord and The day of Christ but you shouldn’t be confused.

<There is no such description as “The day of the Lord” and “The day of Christ” in KJV>

When we examine if there is a distinction between The day of the Lord and The day of Christ, we need to go back to the correct original copy of the Bible. As I mentioned in the last article, the translations of the current copies of the Bible are full of mistakes therefore there is no credibility in them. It is crucial that we have to understand they don’t reflect the correct “majority text” first and foremost.

The Bible which J.N.Darby translated is also base on the incorrect copy. He then claimed there are two different days (The day of the Lord and The day of Christ) and created his own doctrine about Christ returning twice. So, we can't really accept this that easily.

How does the correct copy actually explain about this issue? For example, King James Version which reflects on majority text describes this as written in the scripture reference below.

2 Thessalonians 2:2 (KJV) That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

Surprisingly, KJV also talks about "The day of Christ". Therefore, we can conclude that there are not two days such as the day of the Lord and The day of Christ. The Bible clearly mentions just one day.

The idea of having two separate days is intentionally created by Darby. It was added to the doctrine that Scofield had already made up by himself and is not the doctrine the Bible originally teaches us. We need to understand this.

That is what Pastor Jeremiah shared with us and I hope this article helped you understand his message about the return of Christ.
