"Anointed one will be eliminated" by Jeremiah

Today, I would like to talk about "Anointed one will be eliminated." It is about Holy Spirit disappearing from the church in End Times.

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary, and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

This scripture talks about anointed one will be removed.

<Who is the anointed one?>

Simple question is "Who is the anointed one?"

The answer really is Jesus Christ. He came to Jerusalem as prophesized, but people tried to eliminate and crucified Him.

This prophecy was undoubtedly fulfilled during the life of Jesus, but we need to think from another point of view. I personally presume that this prophecy may be fulfilled again. It was fulfilled first when Jesus came to the earth for the first time, and it may be fulfilled again when He returns.

<Prophecy about End Times is fulfilled twice>

Many prophecies about End Times seem to be fulfilled twice. Let's look at the prophecy about the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem as an example.

Matthew 24:1 And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple.

24:2 And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you; There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

Many scholars point out that this prophecy is meant to be fulfilled twice: when Jesus came to the earth for the first time and in End Times.

I am convinced that this is true and we will witness the destruction of the temple again in End Times.

<Why is Jesus described as "anointed one"?>

Going back to the book of Daniel, we realize how Jesus Christ is called. There are many ways to call Him such as Lamb of God, Savior, The Word of God, and The Light of the World. In this part, He is particularly called as "Anointed One."

The Bible was written by the wisdom of God. Therefore, even the smallest word has God's intention and wisdom behind it. It is never a coincidence. What does God try to achieve through calling Jesus "Anointed One"?

<Anointed One means Holy Spirit>

What we can learn from reading the Bible is that oil means Holy Spirit. Let's have a

look at the scriptures below.

1 John 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.

2:27 But the <u>anointing</u> which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is the truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

It is obvious that "anointing" is related to Holy Spirit, so when we see that anointed one is eliminated, it is prophesying two things.

- 1. Jesus gets crucified and eliminated from the people.
- 2. Holy Spirit which is anointed one is going to be eliminated from the church.

<Other scriptures also predict the elimination of Holy Spirit>

It may sound unbelievable to think that Holy Spirit is going to be eliminated from the church in End Times, but we will see it is prophesized in the Bible as we read it carefully.

2 Thessalonians 2:6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

2:7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he is taken out of the way.

This scripture talks about the day when Holy Spirit is taken away from the church.

Jesus came to the earth as anointed one and savior for Jews, but Jews became against Him and crucified, eliminating the anointed one.

In the same way, Holy Spirit as anointed one will be driven away from the church and eliminated. History repeats.

You may not be able to believe that the church dares to drive out of Holy Spirit, but the Bible clearly talks as below.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

This describes that the church and Christians will be against God and Holy Spirit which could be somehow interpreted for some that it is about the prophecy of elimination of Holy Spirit.

<Christ will be driven out>

This is also stated in Revelation.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hears my voice, and open the door, I will come into him and will dine with him, and he with me.

This part prophesizes about the day when Christ gets driven out of the church. Holy Spirit finally gets kicked out at the church in Laodekia which is the seventh church.

This is what apostasy does and how the anointed one gets eliminated. Let's look at another scripture.

Revelation 7:1 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

Here, it is described that the wind was held to not to blow. The wind means Holy Spirit as it is stated below.

Revelation 3:8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

So, "holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth" indicates that Holy Spirit is going to be eliminated so that He can't work. Let's take a look at one more scripture.

Revelation 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

Euphrates River was the border between Israelites, the people of God, and gentiles in the Old Testament days. In the New Testament days, this is a parable of Holy Spirit who is like a river between Christians and non-Christians. When Euphrates River is dried up, it implies that Holy Spirit is going to be driven out.

<A flood is coming>

Now, what happens to the church after Holy Spirit is driven out?

Let's look at the scripture from Daniel again.

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary, and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

"The people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary" describes that an antichrist will destroy the church which is the sanctuary in the New Testament era. 2 Thessalonians also describes as below.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshiped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

This part prophesizes that an antichrist is going to drive Christ away, establish the seat in the middle of the church, and declare that he is god. We can at least imagine what kind of terrible things will happen to the church beforehand from this.

Before the church places an antichrist on the throne, we will see that extreme accusation against Jesus the Nazareth. People will start to disbelieve in Him, and say Jesus is a liar, therefore, His death on the cross and resurrection were fairly tale.

"the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined."

It is prophesized that a flood of demons will cover the church on the day. This means that the church will become against Jesus and drive Him away, and get influenced by the revival of demons in return. This is exactly what happened when Jesus the anointed one was crucified.

People in the Old Testament days became rebellious and swore at Jesus, shouting "Crucify Him!" They also chose to let Barabbas go free.

This was a prophecy of what is going to happen in the future which means people will drive out Holy Spirit in End Times. They will then accept an antichrist and let him sit on the throne as well as receive a flood of demons and revival of demons at the church.

This will happen rather sooner than later. It is starting to happen indeed. Classic examples are revivals taking place at Pentecostal churches led by Benny Hinn and Bill Hamon. These are revival of demons.

<Crucifixion will return>

Many of you wouldn't believe that the church will become rebellious and deny Christ, but it is prophesized in Revelation.

Revelation 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which

spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

This scripture clearly states that "anointed one" will be crucified at the rebellious church. Jesus in the human flesh doesn't exist now. Therefore, we can see that it is going to be Holy Spirit which is getting crucified.

There will be many apostasies against Christ and Holy Spirit at the rebellious church which is like Sodom and Egypt. The resurrection of Jesus will be said to be a fairy tale and unscientific. Also, any Christians who would believe resurrection and return of Christ will be accused of being cultic. Holy Spirit will be called as Demonic Spirit and get kicked out of the church.

In this way, Crucifixion at the Calvary will be repeated and anointed one will once again get eliminated from the rebellious people. We need to understand that Daniel explains this when it describes "anointed one will be eliminated."

Understand the era "Ecumenical Movement and Chrislam" by H.F

Jesus told us to judge the era, so what kind of era are we in now?

2017 commemorates 500th anniversary of Luther's religious revolution. Therefore, there are many events held around the world. Luther's home country Germany is no exception. In May, "Kirchentag," organized by German Protestant Council was held in Berlin and Wittenberg where there were many attendees with different religious backgrounds from all over the world.

German Chancellor Merkel, former American President Obama, and Melinda Gates (wife of Bill Gates) made a speech along with many other religious leaders (Catholic, Muslim, and Judaism). This event was to commemorate the religious revolution but at the same time somehow represented ecumenical movement.

Right now, Roman Pope and Rick Warren are building a friendship to accelerate the ecumenical movement between Catholic and Protestant.

In Germany, a statistic shows that 1 in 5 people accept the view of combining Catholic and Protestant. The problem is that Catholics see Mary as a redeemer and there are many non-biblical doctrines. The ecumenical movement doesn't end here. We are witnessing that they are trying to combine with cult religions as well without our knowledge.

To say that each religion should not be against each other but instead accept the difference and be tolerant sounds reasonable and peaceful, but ecumenical movement between different religions are progressing. "Chrislam," cross between Christianity and Muslim, is a classic example. They think that Christians and Muslims are both originated from Abraham, therefore, worship the same God.

Roman Catholic also admitted that Allah is the God in the Bible in 1985 led by the Pope of that time. The current Pope ran combined services with Muslims many times. He even prayed in the name of "Merciful almighty God" instead of "Jesus." "Merciful almighty God" is the phrase used by Muslim.

Not only Popes but also many high profile Protestant leaders also run combined services with Muslim to understand each other. They too are considering that Christian God and Muslim God are the same. In Africa, Christianity and Muslim are reported to be slowly getting unified. Nigeria sees increase in violence performed by Muslims and Christians

like any other African countries, so they are trying to solve the problem by unifying Muslims and Christians.

However, is it the truth that Christian God is the same as Muslim God? Some people warn this is not true.

In the berean call, Mr. McMahon stated that Allah is the highest among idol gods which were worshiped by Quraysh tribe. Muhammad then decided to make it as the main god to open a new religion. Archaeological evidence found in Arab tells us that the foundation of Islamic religion comes from worshipping the moon god. For example, the crescent was a symbol of moon god from Babylonian era until Christ's era. This is the reason why Ramadan starts and finishes on the day of crescent.

Muslims kiss black stones, pray towards Mecca and visit temples and this is influenced by the idol worship mentioned above.

If so, it may be fair to assume that Muslim God is different from Christian God. The scripture says "And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17) which clearly describes that Father God has only son Jesus but Allah doesn't have any son. This must be a crucial difference.

Based on these facts, I wonder if it is correct to assume that Christians have the same God as Muslims. You can't pray together, and even if you can, who do you pray to anyway? The faith without Jesus is out of a touch of the truth. It is changed to the different religion. Paul warned the gospel of other religions.

Galatians 1:6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

1:7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

1:8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

It is the time when troubling man is twisting the gospel and truth in Jesus right now.

We need to judge the era correctly.
